## 1.RULES:

The Regatta will be governed by the "Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 and the prescriptions of Yachting New Zealand.

## 2.DIVISIONS:1: Boats measuring 2.4m to 3.6 m in length.

2: Boats measuring 3.6m to 4.2m in length, no spinnakers.

3: Boats measuring 3.6m to 5.5m in length, spinnakers allowed.

## CLASSES:

Class 1; Opti's ,  
FLAG - OPTI CLASS FLAG

Class 2; Bic Skiffs ,  
FLAG- GREEN PENNANT

Class 3; Monohulls under 3.6m  
FLAG- GREEN PENNANT

Class 4; Monohulls 4.2m and under.  
FLAG- LIGHT BLUE PENNANT  
No Spinnakers

Class 5; Monohulls under 5.5m.  
FLAG-PURPLE PENNANT  
Spinnakers allowed

## 3. NOTICES:

Notices to Competitors will be posted on Clubhouse Deck under Flagpole.

## 4.CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Ashore: Signalled by a sound signal , code flag L and written on notice board under Flagpole.

Afloat; Signalled by a sound signal and code flag L and given verbally by Start or Mark boat.

## 5. SCHEDULE OF RACES:

Minimum Three races for each class.

### START SEQUENCE:

1st WARNING SIGNAL scheduled 10:55 am. TBC at 10am briefing.

5min start sequence

Class Start Order and Time will be announced at briefing.

Where a Class start is recalled the order will remain unchanged but following starts will be delayed as required. Start 5min Sequence: 5min-CLASS flag; 4min-BLUE PETER up; 1min-BLUE PETER down; START Class Flag down.

Race 2 Start time TBC at briefing,

Race 3 Start time provisionally as soon as possible after completion of Race 2

## 6. ENTRIES.

Cash Payment or Direct Credit at Algies Bay Clubhouse on Race Days.

No Charge: SYC LTS participants.

\$5.00 SYC Member under 18.

\$10.00 non Member under 18

\$15.00 SYC Member Adult.

\$20.00 non Member Adult.

## 7. RACE AREA.

Algies Bay, Kawau Bay, with Start and Course Area given at 10am briefing at Algies Bay Clubhouse.

## 8. COURSES.

Classes 1 and 2 will sail a triangular course.

Classes 3, 4 and 5 will sail a windward/leeward course.

START LINE between an ORANGE BUOY and RED FLAG on START BOAT.

Courses posted on board at Algies Bay Clubhouse before 10am briefing.

FINISH LINE between an ORANGE BUOY and BLUE FLAG on START BOAT.

Finish in the direction most directly from the previous mark.

## 9. PENALTIES.

720 deg turns penalty will apply for on course infringements under The Rules of Sailing except

360deg turn will apply for Rule 31- touching a mark.

## 10. SCORING.

Rule A4 Low Point Scoring System will apply, all races count.

## 11. PROTESTS.

The Committee would prefer any incidents are resolved with on water turns, but should we be required to adjudicate on a matter a protest form will be available.

Cost: \$20.00 ( the RO can add zeros after the 2 at his/her discretion if required)

## 12. PRIZES.

This is RACE DAY 2 of a three race regatta series.

The BIC CLASS will be racing for the Algies Bay Residents Association Trophy with points accumulated over 3 days of racing.

The BIC CLASS will also be racing ON THE DAY, Day 2, for the GREEN FLEET TROPHY.

LASER yachts will be racing for the RODNEY TIMES TROPHY. Points will be accumulative over Day 2 and Day 3 of the series.

Spot prizes to be awarded on the day.
